



2017-2018 IUPUI and IUPUC Dependency Override Renewal

General Information for Requesting a Dependency Status Override

A student with an approved Dependency Override for the 2016-2017 aid year at IUPUI or IUPUC who does not meet the federal criteria for independent status on the 2017-2018 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) may submit this renewal form (with supporting documentation) for review and determination of unusual circumstances. The Higher Education Act allows a Financial Aid Administrator to make dependency overrides on a case-by-case basis for students with unusual circumstances.

Please Note: Parent(s) refusal/inability to contribute to your education, parents not claiming you on their tax return, and/or you supporting yourself are not considered extenuating circumstances. Approved unusual circumstances would include but are not limited to death of parents, an abusive family environment or abandonment by parents.

Submission: You may e-mail or fax your application to our office as indicated below. You will receive an e-mail notification in your IUPUI or IUPUC email account of the decision within ten business days.
